NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Ryan Ronco, Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, in accordance with the provisions of the Election Laws of the State of California, on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, there will be a Statewide Direct Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, at the Statewide Direct Primary Election, candidates will be nominated or elected to the following offices:

**FEDERAL VOTER-NOMINATED OFFICES:** United States Representative, District 3; United States Representative, District 4; United States Representative, District 6

**STATE LEGISLATIVE VOTER-NOMINATED OFFICES:** State Senator, District 4; State Senator, District 6; State Assembly Member, District 1; State Assembly Member, District 3; State Assembly Member, District 5

**STATE VOTER-NOMINATED OFFICES:** Governor; Lieutenant Governor; Attorney General; Secretary of State; Controller; Treasurer; Insurance Commissioner; State Superintendent of Public Instruction; State Board of Equalization, District 1

**COUNTY NON-PARTISAN OFFICES:** Supervisor, District 1; Supervisor, District 2; Assessor; Auditor-Controller; Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters; Treasurer-Tax Collector; Superintendent of Schools

**JUDICIAL:** Superior Court Judge, Seat 1; Superior Court Judge, Seat 2; Superior Court Judge, Seat 3

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the official nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy for eligible Placer County residents desiring to file for an elective office may be obtained from the Placer County Elections Office located at 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765. Completed Placer County nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy must be returned to the Elections Office for filing.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that candidate filing begins at the Placer County Elections Office on Monday, Feb. 9, and will close Friday, March 6, after which time no Declaration of Candidacy may be accepted for filing. If an incumbent does not file their Declaration of Candidacy on or

before Mar. 6, the period for all non-incumbents to obtain and return their nomination and declaration paperwork will be extended to Wednesday, March 11.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the hours for filing nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy during the filing period (and extended period, if necessary) will be Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., excluding holidays (Lincoln's Birthday, Feb. 9 and President's Day, Feb. 16).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Placer County Elections Office will provide candidate filing services at the Placer County Clerk-Recorder's Office at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn and at the Tahoe Customs House at 775 North Lake Blvd in Tahoe City on select days and by appointment only during the candidate filing period.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if the boundaries of a district have changed since the last time offices associated with that district were up for election, there is no incumbent for that office, and the extension of candidate filing will not apply. This is also true for districts who have transitioned from "at-large" elections to elections by trustee area, district or division.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the random alphabet draw will be held on Thursday, March 12 at 11 a.m. to determine the ballot order of candidates' names.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that appointment to each elective office will be made as prescribed by Section 10515 in the event there are no nominees or an insufficient number of nominees for the office and a petition for an election is not filed with the elections official within the period prescribed by Section 10515 of the Elections Code.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election is Monday, May 18. Conditional Voter Registration is available beginning Tuesday, May 19 through Election Day (June 2) for those that miss the registration deadline and want to register to vote and receive a ballot the same day.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN the last day for the Elections Office to mail a requested ballot is Tuesday, May 26.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that Placer County adopted the Voter's Choice Act in 2023. This means Placer County will have a select number of vote centers open 10 days before Election Day, with the remaining opening three days before Election Day. During this period, vote centers will be open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. Voters no longer have an assigned polling place and can go to any vote center throughout the County on any of the aforementioned days. On Election Day, all vote centers will be open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that after the polls close at 8 p.m. on Election Day, June 2, the ballots will be transported to the central counting location at the Placer County Elections Office, 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the opening and processing of the mailed ballots for said election will take place at the Placer County Elections Office starting Tuesday, May 5, and continue through Election Night, June 2.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence on or before 8 a.m. on Wednesday,

June 3 at the Placer County Elections Office.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Elections Office will be open the two weekends prior to the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election (May 23 - 24 and May 30-31), and on the observed holiday of Memorial Day, May 25, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, in accordance with provisions of the election laws of the State of California, that on Wednesday, June 3 at 10 a.m., the Placer County Elections Office will randomly select precincts and batches for a manual tally of no less than one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this random selection of precincts and batches is open to the public.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on Tuesday, June 9 at 9 a.m., the Placer County Elections Office will begin a manual tally of no less than one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
