September 14, 2021  
California Gubernatorial Recall Election**

<b>July 16 – 31, 2021</b> (E-60 through E-45)	<b>Ballots for military and overseas voters (UOCAVA) issued.</b> (E.C. §§ 3105(b), 3114, 20302, 52 U.S.C.)
<b>August 30, 2021</b> (E-15)	<b>Last day to register to vote for this election.</b> (E.C. §2102)
<b>September 7, 2021</b> (E-7)	<b>Last day to request a vote by mail ballot to be sent by mail.</b> (E.C. §§ 3001, 3003, 3102)
<b>September 14, 2021</b> (E-0)	<b>Election Day</b> (E.C. §§ 1000(c), 14212)
<b>September 21, 2021</b> (E+7)	<b>Last day to receive a ballot by mail that is postmarked on or before Election Day.</b> (E.C. § 1605)
<b>2 days prior to the certification of the Election.</b>	<b>Last day to receive an Unsigned Ballot Statement or Signature Verification Statement by 5:00 PM.</b> (If there were any signatures issues on vote by mail envelope.) (E.C. § 3019)

**Note, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the United States Postal Service may be experiencing delays in mail service which may cause military and overseas voters to face challenges with receiving and returning ballots by mail in a timely manner. As such, we are strongly encouraging our military and overseas voters to request to receive their ballot by email to bypass delays and mail disruptions. If you opt to receive your materials via email, then you would be able to return your ballot by fax or mail.**
