August 8 – 17 (E-87 - E-78)	10-day public inspection period for arguments for and against the measure.	<i>Elec. Code § 9190</i>
August 17 (E-78)	Last day to file rebuttal arguments for and against all measures.	<i>Elec. Code §§ 9167, 9317</i>
August 18 – 27 (E-77 - E-68)	10-day public inspection period for rebuttal arguments for and against the measure, if applicable.	<i>Elec. Code § 9190</i>
September 24 (E-40)	County Voter Information Guides may be mailed to voters by this date.	<i>Elec. Code § 13303(a), 13305</i>
October 5 (E-29)	Ballots mailed to all active registered voters. First day to begin processing ballots.	<i>Elec. Code §§ 3001, 3010, 15101</i>
October 19 (E-15)	Last day to register to vote for this election.	<i>Elec. Code § 2102 (a)(1)</i>
October 20 (E-14)	First day for conditional registration for this election.	<i>Elec. Code § 2170 (a)</i>
October 27 (E-7)	Last day to request a ballot by mail.	<i>Elec. Code § 4005 (8)(B)(i)(IV)</i>
