I've seen how government agencies can either encourage or discourage people from choosing our community for their home or their family-owned business.</p> <p>Unfortunately, SPMUD has adopted policies that are increasing the costs of housing and opening and operating family-owned businesses and restaurants. SPMUD currently has one of the highest fees in the region to connect to sewer services and recently approved a 24% increase. One family-owned business recently received a bill for more than \$70,000 when it moved locations within a shopping center, despite no increase in sewage discharge.</p> <p>I would bring a fresh perspective to the SPMUD Board, one that considers the impacts of SPMUD's policies on families and businesses. I have served on the Board of Directors for the Rocklin Chamber of Commerce and Rocklin Soccer and currently serve on the Placer Valley Tourism Board of Directors.
