NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Ryan Ronco, Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, in accordance with the provisions of the Election Laws of the State of California, that on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, there will be an all-mail ballot election to be held in the McKinney Water District.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the Governing Board Member Election, three (3) candidates will be elected to the governing board of the McKinney Water District for four (4) year terms.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that official Nomination Petitions and Declarations of Candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for the above elective offices may be obtained from the Placer County Elections Office, 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, excluding holidays. Completed Declarations of Candidacy shall be returned to the Placer County Elections Office by the end of the filing period.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that filing is open Monday, July 17, 2023, and will close Friday, August 11, 2023, after which time no Declarations of Candidacy may be accepted for filing. If an incumbent does not file his or her Declaration of Candidacy on or before August 11, 2023, the period for all non-incumbents to obtain and return Declarations of Candidacy will be extended to Wednesday, August 16, 2023. Office hours will be the same as above. During this extended filing period only, official Nomination Petitions and Declarations of Candidacy desiring to file for the above elective offices may be obtained from the Placer County Elections Office at its new address, 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765, Monday, August 14, 2023 through Wednesday, August 16, 2023, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Completed Declarations of Candidacy shall be returned to the Placer County Elections Office by the end of the filing period.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the Special District Election is October 23, 2023.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the election will be conducted by mail ballot only and that every qualified voter will be issued a mail ballot. Placer County Elections staff will be available to accept voted ballots and issue replacement ballots at the Placer County Elections Office, 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765, from October 9, 2023 through November 7, 2023 during regular office hours, as posted. Staff will also be available to accept voted ballots and

issue replacement ballots at the Placer County Elections Office, November 7, 2023 from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that all ballots will begin to be mailed on October 9, 2023. The last day for the Elections Office to mail a requested ballot is October 31, 2023.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that there is a 24/7 ballot drop box available outside the Placer County Elections Office, 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765. The drop box will be accessible beginning October 9, 2023, and available until 8:00 PM on November 7, 2023.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the central counting location is at the Placer County Elections Office, 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that per Elections Code 15101 and 15104, the Registrar of Voters hereby notifies all interested organizations that the verifying of signatures on vote-by-mail ballots cast for the all-mail ballot election will commence on October 9, 2023, or at any time thereafter in the County Elections Office.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on October 9, 2023, or at any time thereafter, the opening and processing of vote-by-mail ballots will commence. This process will begin during regular business hours, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and will continue until all election results are tabulated and the election is certified.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the opening and processing of the vote-by-mail ballots for said election will take place at the Placer County Elections Office at 3715 Atherton Road, Rocklin, CA 95765. Any member of the County Grand Jury, and any other interested organization, shall be permitted to observe the processing of ballot return envelopes through the opening, counting and disposition of the ballots.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence on or before 8:00 AM on November 8, 2023 at the Placer County Elections Office.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN in accordance with provisions of the election laws of the State of California, that on November 8, 2023, at 10:00 AM, the Elections Office will randomly select precincts for a manual tally of one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the November 7, 2023 Special District Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this random selection of precincts is open to the public.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on November 9, 2023 at 9:00 AM, the Placer County Elections Office will begin a manual tally of one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the November 7, 2023 Special District Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
