The Placer County Office of Elections will conduct a free Candidate Workshop on **February 20, 2016**. It will begin at **10:00 AM** and end at approximately **1:00 PM** for prospective candidates. The workshop will be held at the Office of Elections, located at 2956 Richardson Drive, in the DeWitt Center in Auburn.

The workshop will cover the following topics:

- Filing times, dates, and deadlines for candidates running in the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election
- Forms required to file for public office
- Offices up for election
- Effective campaigning techniques
- Election data products
- Media involvement

Prospective candidates and their supporters, members of the media and the general public are all invited to attend this free workshop. The workshop will explain many of the details involved in running for public office. If you are interested in becoming a candidate this workshop is a good starting point.

A panel of guest speakers will share their knowledge and experience in a wide range of topics. Speakers will include Jim McCauley, the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters along with knowledgeable election staff, successful candidates, and the media. There will also be a question and answer period for the audience.

The candidate-filing period for the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election opens February 15, 2016 and closes March 11, 2016. Filing is approaching fast. Get involved in your community and consider becoming a candidate!
