All Placer County registered voters will begin receiving their November 6, 2018 General Election County Voter Information Guide at the end of this month.

The county voter information guide will provide voters with important information about items to be voted on this election. In addition, your polling place location is listed on the back cover of your county voter information guide. If you are a permanent vote-by-mail voter or if you reside in a mail ballot precinct, your guide will read **Permanent Vote-by-Mail Voter or Mail Ballot Precinct** in the polling place location area of the guide.

For voters who are not permanent vote-by-mail voters and voters who do not reside in a mail ballot precinct, the back cover of the voter information guide can be used as a vote-by-mail ballot application. Simply sign the form return it to the Placer County Elections Office or call to request a ballot to be mailed to you: 530-886-5650 or toll-free in California 1-800-824-8683. Remember, if you are a **Permanent Vote-by-Mail Voter**, a request for a vote-by-mail ballot is **not** necessary. You will automatically receive your ballot in the mail.

Vote-by-mail ballots will begin mailing on October 8, 2018. You can either use the vote-by-mail ballot request form on your county voter information guide, download a request form from our website at www.placerelections.com, or call our office to request a ballot to be mailed to you: 530-886-5650, toll-free in California 1-800-824-8683, or email us your application at election@placer.ca.gov. To ensure sufficient processing time, the last day by law that the Elections Office can mail a voter-requested vote-by-mail ballot is October 30, 2018. You may pick up a vote-by-mail ballot in our office from October 8, 2018 through Election Day, November 6, 2018. The Elections Office is located at 2956

Richardson Drive in Auburn. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Election Day hours are 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

If you do not receive your county voter information guide by October 9, 2018 or if you misplace your voter information guide, please contact the Elections Office at 530-886-5650 or toll free in California 1-800-824-8683 for a duplicate.
